On April 20, National Grid will host an Earth Day employee volunteer event at Seatuck Environmental Association and the South Shore Nature Center located in Islip.

The **Seatuck Environmental Association** is a not-for-profit, member supported organization dedicated to promoting the conservation of Long Island's wildlife and environment, through education, research and advocacy. Seatuck operates The Suffolk County Environmental Center, a 70-acre public nature center located near the shores of the Great South Bay.

The **South Shore Nature Center** is a public recreation and outdoor education facility jointly owned by the Town of Islip and The Nature Conservancy. The South Shore Nature Center has 206 acres of woods and a range of habitats including a sandy shoreline overlooking the Great South Bay and a beautiful untouched forest.

National Grid volunteers will participate in a variety of outdoor projects at both sites including grooming trails, clearing and dispersing fallen tree branches, spreading woodchips and removing debris.
